In a democracy, everyone's voice matters equally. So it's completely unjust that so many people on lower incomes get shut out from using their vote. The Poverty Alliance is working with voterchampion.org.uk to make sure that 300,000 eligible voters don't lose their right to vote because they aren't registered. Get registered!

You **MUST** be registered to vote before midnight on Tuesday 18 June - or you won't be able to vote in the General Election! It's simple to do. Just complete the short form on this website: gov.uk/register-to-vote



Get your ID ready!

You **MUST** have photo ID to vote at a UK General Election. There is information on what ID is acceptable here: gov.uk/how-to-vote/photo-id-youll-need If you need it, you can apply for a free Voter Photo ID here: gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate



Get a postal vote!
